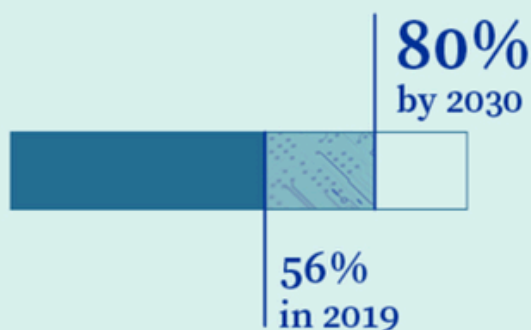

The EU's 'Digital Decade' targets by 2030

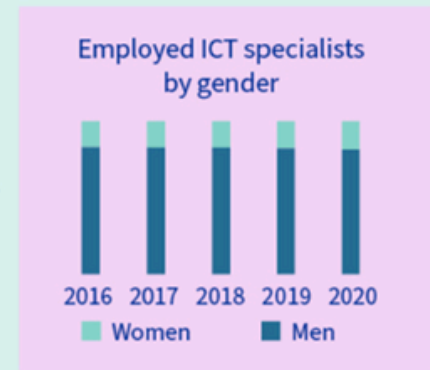
1. Skills

→ 80% of people aged 16-74 have basic digital skills

→ all EU population enjoy Gigabit and 5G connectivity everywhere, including rural and remote areas

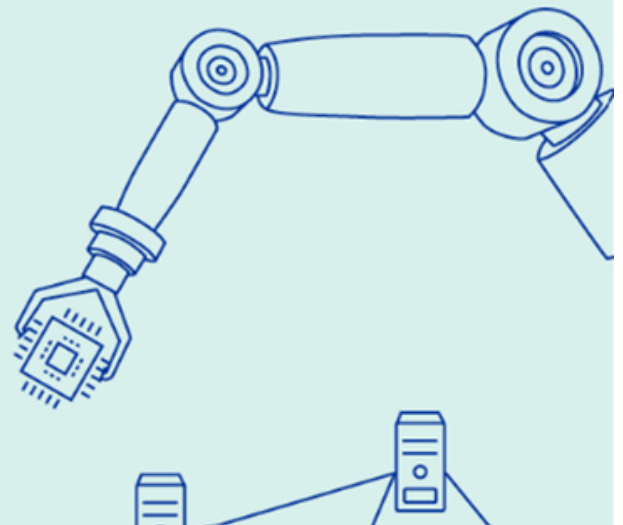
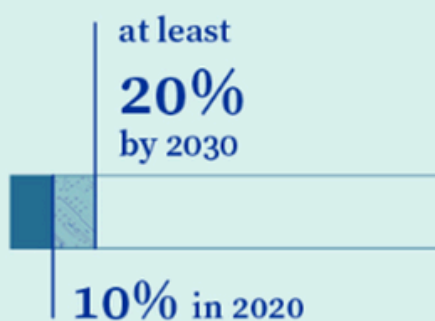

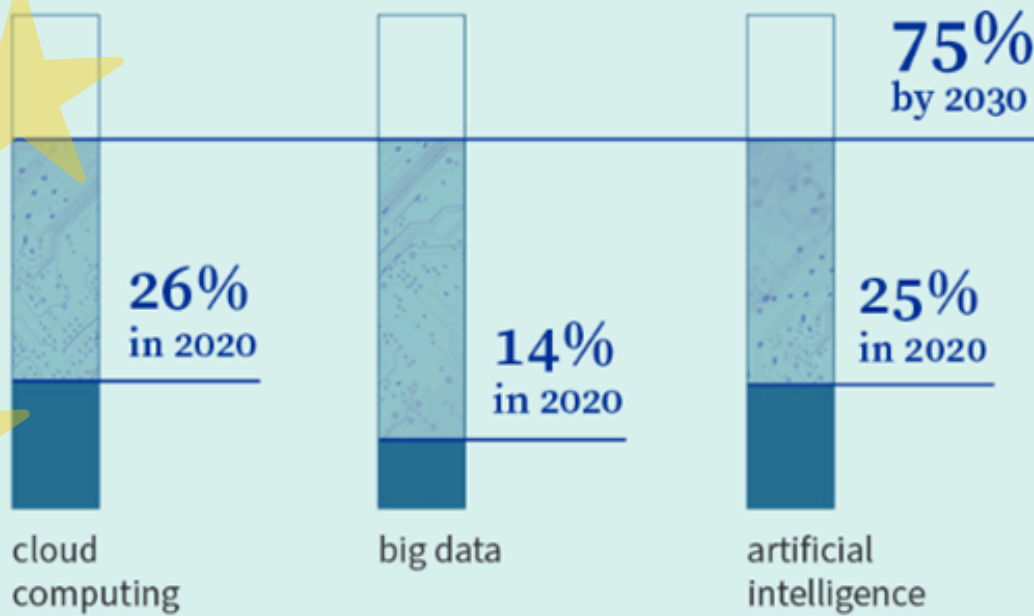


→ the EU accounts for at least 20% of the world's microchip production in value

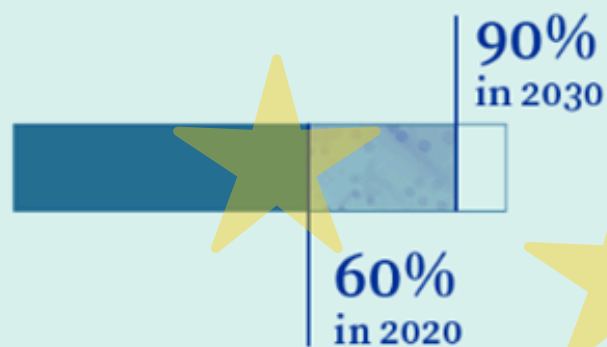


3. Businesses

→ 75% of enterprises use cloud computing, big data and artificial intelligence



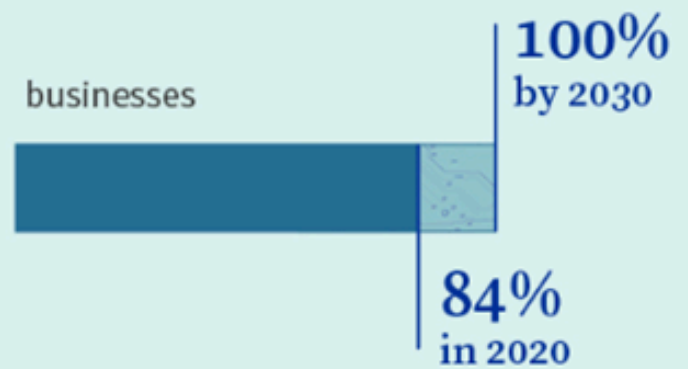
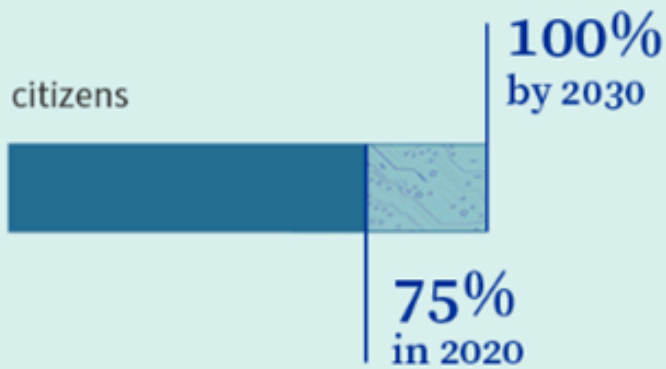
→ 90% of SME* reach at least a basic level of digital intensity (= use a minimum of four particular technologies)



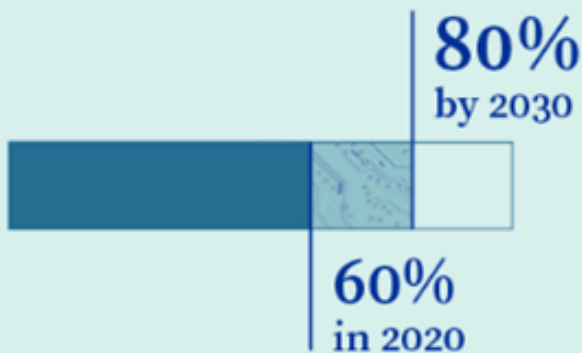
SMEs in the EU account for 99% of all businesses

How it will work in practice

To reach these common objectives, the member states will work together, assessing progress towards the agreed targets and taking measures where necessary.



the EU and member states establish **roadmaps at EU and national level** to achieve the targets



the Commission presents an **annual report** on progress and recommendations



the EU countries and the Commission team up to work out the best way to **address performance gaps** and ensure progress



the member states **adjust their national roadmaps** to reflect the recommended actions

The EU countries and the Commission may, at any stage, establish **joint commitments** or **multi-country projects** to help achieve the targets.
