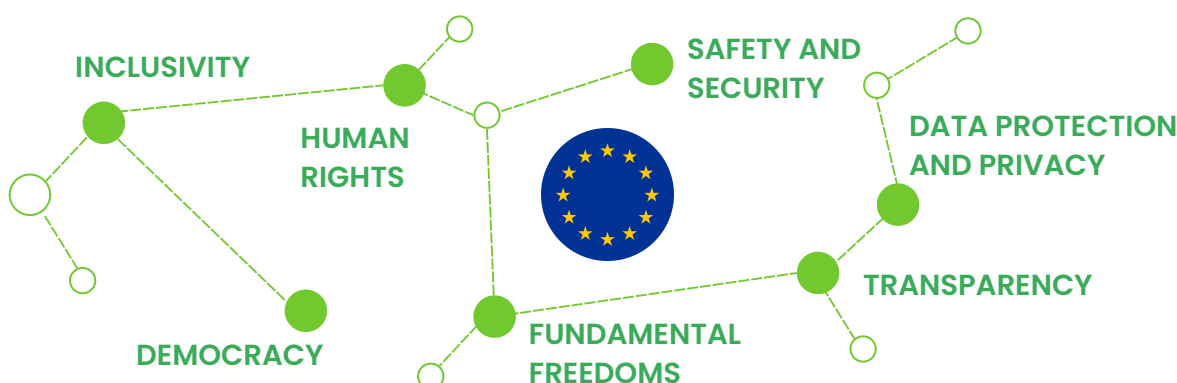


What is illegal offline must also be illegal online



The digital world, omnipresent in our daily lives and dominated by digital giants, requires us to use secure technologies while developing the skills and competitiveness of European digital and AI technologies.

The EU invests in strategic digital capabilities and large-scale deployment of digital technologies according to its own values:



The European Digital Services Regulation aims to make platforms more accountable

- All online intermediaries offering their services (goods, content or services) on the European market are covered
- What is illegal offline is illegal online

The Digital Market Act aims to put an end to the domination of the Internet giants

- Create fair competition between digital players, particularly for the benefit of small and medium-sized enterprises and European start-ups
- Strengthening European consumers' freedom of choice

Since August 2023

The DSA has already applied to 17 designated platforms with more than 45 million users in the EU, to very large online platforms and to 2 very large online search engines.

Since February 2024

The rules of the Digital Services Act apply to all platforms.
